

- ✓ What is the scholarship?
- What is the scholarship about?
  - √What is the maximum award?
  - Is there a GPA requirement?
  - ✓ Online or paper application?
- Where does your application need to be submitted?
  - Does it need an essay?



# More Requirements to Consider...

- ✓ |s a transcript required?
- ✓ Is your family's financial information required?
- When is the deadline? ... Postmarked or received by deadline?

# TEACHER MUST MAIL

Provide an addressed envelope with postage.



# TEACHER MUST SUBMIT ONLINE

Give the teacher all of the information that is needed to submit online.



# MUSTBE SENT WITH APP

Pick up from teacher and mail with the rest of your app in a sealed envelope.

# SOME RED FLAGS...

"This scholarship is guaranteed or your money back."

"You can't get this information anywhere else."

"I just need your credit card or bank account number to hold this scholarship."

"The scholarship will cost money."

# NEVER PAY A FEE TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP!



- ·Adhere to deadlines! ·Start early! Set aside some time to work on applying for scholarships.
- Follow the instructions carefully.
- Use your résumé to help you complete applications.
