Discussions and Topics:

1. November Minutes review

- Ted requested clarification on financials in section 6 of minutes—Cathy to modify.
- Sandi N. approved, Glen H., second motion (with the change)

2. Principal's Report – Dan Bledsoe

- Rachel's Challenge schedule for this week (double assembly scheduled)
- Toy Drive under way this week
- Finishing up second quarter progress reports
- Ted requested more details on Rachel's Challenge (Rachel was first student killed in Columbine shooting)
- Ed Katz brought up thefts at school and requested comment from Dan. Dan stated that thefts at DVHS were no different from other high schools. He further stated that students are often careless with their phones and iPods thus susceptible to easy thefts from others.

3. Athletic Director's Report – Brian Freitas

- Academic statistics were turned into NCS
- DHVS qualified for 7 banners (varsity sports only)
- Banners are for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place banners
- Fall sports completed (4 of 8 teams qualified for NCS)
- Football Varsity finished with 8 wins, 3 losses; Girls Golf at 10 wins, 2 losses, Boys Cross Country finished 10th in Division 4 NCS; Girls Tennis finished in Division 2.
- Winter sports began with Boys Soccer beating Northgate HS (1-0); Girls Varsity Basketball beat Newark by 30 points.
- Special thanks to Tony Aiello for being the voice of the Wildcats (not only football but will announce basketball as well).
- Athletic Booster will take charge of the snack concessions during basketball games but Boys/Girls Basketball parents will volunteer to sell at the games during the entire season.
- Snack Shack volunteers have been scheduled for the basketball games.

- 25% of proceeds will go Boys/Girls basketball teams; 75% will go to Athletic Boosters.
- DVHS Baseball team (varsity) scheduled to play at the Oakland Coliseum on May 15, 2009 as the second game of a double header. Livermore vs Granada will be the first game.
- DVHS holding NorCal coaches clinic on February 7, 2009- breakfast and Lunch will be available at the Snack Shack.
- Athletes of the month: Angela Han and Alex Small and will be announced at the January 6th and 9th basketball games.

4. Financial Report – Glen Hori

- Reviewed Balance Sheet
- Total income = \$4,128.09; Net Income = \$2,856.47
- Balance Sheet: Total Assets = \$40,350.81
- Will move away from US Bank
- Estimated outflow through March 09 - \$15k for conditioning program coach, \$5k for athletic trainer

5. Sports Brochures – Ted Carter/Glen Hori

- 300 brochures printed, estimated 100 sold through December
- Winter sports estimated to have 180+ athletes
- Spring sports estimated to have 200+ athletes
- Members brought up the idea of including the brochures with membership donations—to be discussed again.

- Alex Mahan of Sunset Development will present \$5000 check to DVHS at Christmas Lighting ceremony on December 4th between 5:30 and 7:30pm.
- Christmas Tree sales was a success with net profit of \$4,370.
- Trees will be on sale on Dec. 7th between 11-5pm
- Ed and Tony proposes pre-sale of trees next year
- Asconas to Asconas Fun Run is scheduled for 4/24/09
- Volunteer and committee members planning meeting will be held on December 11th at 7pm at Asconas. (Free Pizza and sodas) for those attending.
- Other Sponsorship news: 24 hr Fitness to be targeted for sponsorship; 3 responses from mailer
- Will use Hopyard for raffle items
- Golf Tournament to honor Kashmir Billon – scheduled for June 15, 2009
- The Bridges is a tentative golf course for event

- Fat Cactus Food donation = 3% (Wednesdays)
